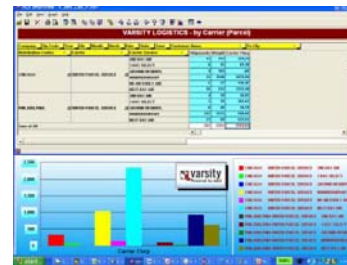
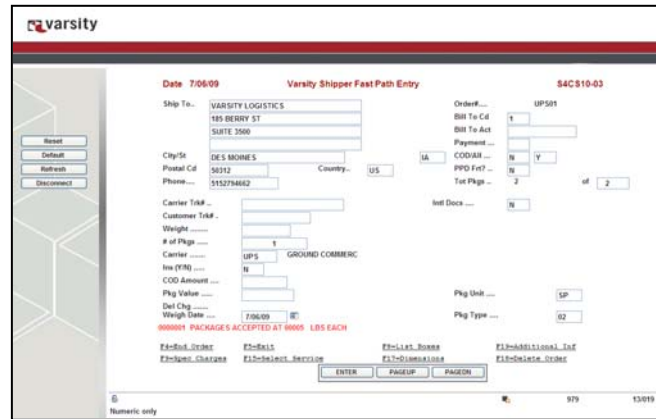




Technical Training Agenda ON-LINE – October 4 - 8, 2010
